

## Case study- KYN – Kasia

Kasia is a woman, originally from Poland. She has moved to Sunderland from in London with her husband and three children during Covid-19 pandemic, due to this she did not know many people in Sunderland. She met a volunteer who was participating in ICOS Women's group, the volunteer has introduced her to ICOS in January 2023.
